

### About the Exhibition

This public exhibition of nine sculptures by Carole Eisner has been organized by the Broadway Mall Association in conjunction with the Parks Department and Susan Eley Fine Art. The display starts to the south with the whimsical "Walter" at Dante Park, located within the Lincoln Square Business Improvement District, which plants and maintains the malls from 60th-70th Streets. The exhibit continues north along eight more malls, culminating with the dramatic and monumental "Swizzle" at 166th Street.

### About the Artist

Eisner has been welding abstract sculptures from scrap and recycled metal for over 40 years. The pieces on view span the past 20 years of her career, and all reflect the surprising malleability she finds with metal. Eisner's work has been exhibited in dozens of public parks, corporate plazas, cultural centers, museums and waterfronts in Connecticut, New York, Massachusetts, New Jersey and Florida and in solo shows in Belgium and France. The artist lives and works in New York and Connecticut.

### About the Broadway Mall Association

The Broadway Mall Association is a non-profit organization that works in partnership with community residents, non-profit groups, local businesses and the Parks Department to beautify and maintain the malls of Broadway from West 70th to West 168th Street.

### About the Public Art Division of the NYC Department of Parks & Recreation

Since 1967 the Parks Department has hosted over 1,000 temporary outdoor art displays in parks citywide. The works have included both readymade sculpture and installations inspired by the characteristics and landscape of a specific site.

### About Susan Eley Fine Art

Susan Eley Fine Art was founded in 2006 and is located on New York's Upper West Side. The Gallery focuses on contemporary paintings, photographs and sculptures. In celebration of the Broadway Malls exhibition, the Gallery is hosting "In the Abstract" featuring small sculptures by Eisner and paintings by Liane Ricci, on view from September 17-November 6.

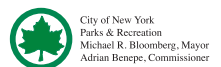

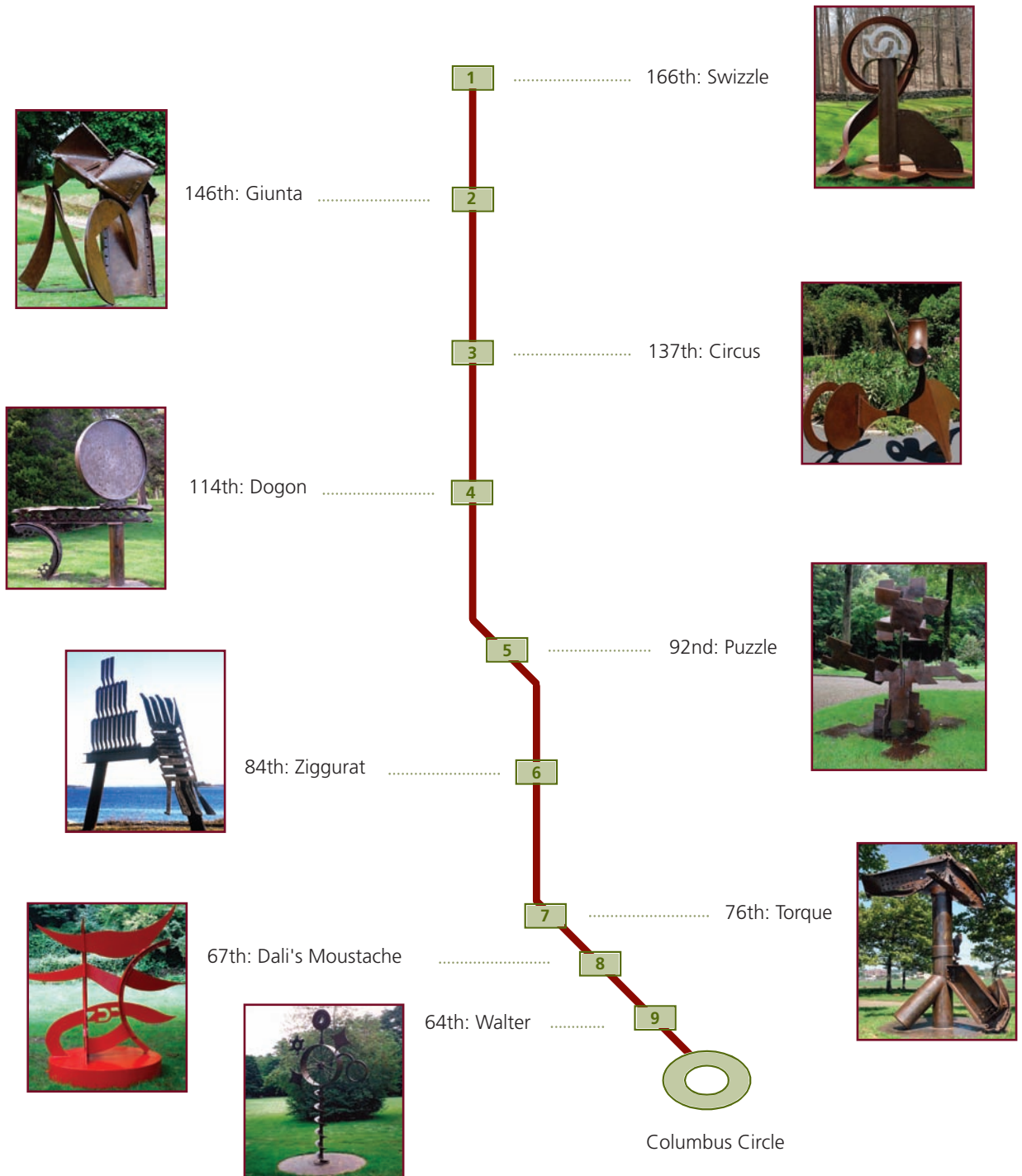
